MALAYSIAN CONTRACT BRIDGE ASSOCIATION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The two events 6th South East Bridge Federation Championships ("SEABFC") and 39th Asean Bridge Club Championships ("ABCC") will run as one tournament. The organisers have determined that only citizens of respective South East Asian nations are eligible for the SEABFC while non-citizens will play for the ABCC. The teams will qualify to separate pools (SEABF and ABCC) where there is a qualification round; if not, the SEABF and ABCC teams in each event will be ranked respectively.

- 1. Entries must be made online at the Championship website, on or before 10 November 2023, together with the payment of entry fees. Please note all the necessary deadlines especially payment of fees and submission of convention cards
- 2. All entries for the SEABFC must comprise fully of Malaysian citizens and copies of NRIC must be verified by MCBA
- 3. MCBA will provide a subsidy for the team entry fees only (Open/Ladies/Senior teams USD400; Mixed Teams USD150) for teams comprising FULLY of MCBA paid up members as at 31 October 2023. There is no subsidy for Open Pairs
- 4. There is no subsidy for travel or lodging
- 5. Teams which earn a podium finish will be granted a cash reward of RM1000; RM500 and RM250 per team for first, second and third respectively provided that the event has at least six teams
- 6. The subsidy will be paid on a reimbursement basis upon completion of the event and submission of the Team Captain's report
- 7. The Team Captain is responsible to ensure all the team members are fully informed of the terms and conditions of the event; including the playing schedule
- 8. Accommodation at the venue hotel may be made on the Championship website
